(1) Standards and methods for the valuation of securities Held-to-maturity securities are accounted for at amortized cost. Investment securities other than held-to-maturity securities are carried at fair value.

(2) Depreciation methods of fixed assets Depreciation charges of building fixtures, furniture and equipments are computed using the straight-line method.

(3) Basis for appropriation of reserves

In preparation for the payment of bonuses to executives and employees, bonus reserves are provided for the anticipated amount of bonuses attributable to the current fiscal year.

Pursuant to the abolishment of the retirement benefit scheem, retirement benefit reserves are provided for the total of the amount of benefits payable in case that relevant executives and employees leave as of May 31, 2011, and the amount of after tax interest on the retirement benefit reserve assets for the period susequent to October 1, 2012.

(4) Accounting for consumption taxes Consumption taxes are accounted for by the tax excluded method.
